JOB DESCRIPTION

Must be at least 21 years of age and possess a PV license from NY State (we can help you obtain one); Must also be experienced with all aspects of inboard/outboard powerboats and non-power boats (such as sailboats, canoes, rowboats); Thoroughly knowledgeable in safety procedures.

REQUIREMENTS

The following are preferred or required:

- Must have a passion for representing Christ as an employee of COTW
- Be personable and outgoing with a variety of different people
- Commit to the team culture where everyone is treated with honor, dignity, and respect.
- Must have a servant's heart, keeping the needs of fellow team members and COTW members at the heart of your work

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Follow open and shutdown procedures of the marina at the beginning and end of each season. (Complete Preseason & Postseason Checklist).
- Train the crew members on boat handling, mechanics, chain of command, where to get help, when to escalate situations, who to escalate them to, correct docking techniques and patterns, a map of rocks on the lake, etc.
- Hold boat crew members accountable to appropriate boat usage on time off; ensure that boats are being used with their intended purposes in mind.
- Be aware and adhere to the budget.
- Conducts performance reviews of boat crew members in regard to work and character; reviews with staff members in a timely fashion.
- Must be thorough in operating each watercraft.
- Oversee the operation/maintenance of the marine department and its equipment, boat rentals, gasoline sales, speedboat rides, pulling water skiers, etc.
- Operate Tapawingo shuttle service; deliver meals each day, pull skiers
