## **Qualifications & Expectations for COTW Small Group Leaders**

## Qualifications

- Dedicated Follower of Christ
  - None of our small group leaders are *"perfect Christians"*. Nobody is! However, they are individuals who are committed to following Christ on a daily basis.
- Age
  - Must be 18+, 20+ is preferred.
- Training Date
  - All small group leaders must attend our first small group leaders' meeting and training on <u>Friday</u>, June 14<sup>th</sup> from 6:15 PM – 9 PM.
- Prior Experience
  - Prior experience serving as a small group leader is <u>not</u> necessary. We want humble, teachable individuals who desire to build a community of believers who are focused on growing in their walk with Christ.

## Expectations

- Arrival
  - Small group leaders are expected to report to camp the day before challenge week begins, Friday, June 14<sup>th</sup>
- Our mission is to build and establish a community that draws near to Christ.
  - Small group leaders help to build this community within our staff.
- Weekly Small Group Leaders Meeting
  - Small group leaders will be scheduled for a weekly meeting from 7:15 PM 7:45 PM (30 mins total) on Sunday nights, prior to Staff Chapel.
- Weekly Small Group Leadership
  - All staff are required to be in small groups on Sunday night from 9 PM 10 PM. This will be the set time when small group leaders will lead their small group.
- One-on-Ones
  - All small group leaders are required to meet with their small group members one-on-one at least once, within the **first two weeks of camp**.
    - Each small group has 5 8 members.
    - One-on-ones are typically 30 mins 60 mins.
  - After the initial one-on-one, it is *encouraged* to meet with small group members **one additional time** before summer's end.
- Share Your Testimony
  - Each staff member at COTW will share a 10 15 min. version of their testimony within their small groups.
  - Small group leaders will be the first to share their testimony within their small group.

## • Quiet Time Accountability

- Small group leaders are encouraged to regularly ask their small group members how their quiet time is going.
- Small group leaders should be spending time in God's word on a regular basis and lead by example.
