JOB DESCRIPTION

The Head Lifeguard leads a staff of four other lifeguard to manage and offer a safe waterfront to guests. Works shifts to guard and monitor beachfront, provides swim instruction, and schedules other guards.

REQUIREMENTS

The following are preferred or required:

- Must have a current (within one year of current summer) Lifeguard training or Advanced Lifesaving certificate, plus First Aid, plus a Waterfront Module, and CPR (COTW can provide or reimburse)
- Lifeguard Management Course (COTW can provide or reimburse)
- Previous lifeguarding leadership and swim instruction experience
- Knowledge of general beach safety and maintenance
- Leadership skills and desire to represent Christ in all things

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Handle a large weight of responsibility with maturity
- Lead, supervise, and schedule four other lifeguard staff
- Communicate and enforce safety policies and regulations
- Responsible for safety procedures and the welfare of people in large beachfront and swimming areas
- Responsible to guard swimming area and monitor beach activity
- · Provide swim instruction as needed
